MINUTES of the meeting held on January 27th to January 31th
2020

This meeting's objectives are:

- introductions of the partner institutions
- organization of the project
- establishing novelties in the existing agenda
- sharing and distribution of the tasks
- establishing the rules of the project
- signing off the partnership contract
- comparing the findings of the first questionnaires
- the coordinator runs the presentations of the digital stories, •presenting each country's national educational system
- promotion of the objective regarding each national cultural heritage
- designing the outline of the project's website.

Working together aiming at common goals, using diverse activities such as combining work by hand with the use of ICT, and finally, exploring stories and different cultures to develop our project activities and outcomes, are all practices that help participants realize that harmony, mutual cooperation and peace can be practically applied among different cultures who are working together.

During the short-term joint staff training event held at UPESLEJU ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, the following activities took place:

WORKDAY 1

We started the day with the visiting the most important sightseeing place in Riga Old town. Welcom ceremony. The partners were welcomed at Upesleju elementary school by the teachers and students with the short artistic, folk program. After that followed toured guide around the school and kindergarten. The participants took part in the Latvian traditional folk program "How to become a Latvian" and tasted Latvian traditional cuisine.

WORKDAY 2

Each partner country presented their countries, schools, educational systems, and the activities done until this project meeting. Two open lessons was held to enable the guest teachers to see how the hosting country has integrated stories into their daily teaching practice with the help of ICT in order to expand their school's curricula. Participants have received two lesson plans / summaries that can be can implement in the classroom as examples of good practice in their schools. Workshop and work session about project tasks- "Story telling in education by non formal methods".

WORKDAY 3

Digital story workshop, we make mixed brad story from all partners countries fairy tally with experienced teacher by animation method. Easy App is Adobe Premiere Pro, where each country can make digital story with child. After workshop exhibition with results of workshop. After was followed by the Regional Television interview with the project participants in order to inform wider audience.

WORKDAY 4

Partner schools discovered the cultural heritage of Sigulda . They visited the historical Sigulda castle “Story telling in Sigulda castle” and more storytelling types in Munchausen’s World .

WORKDAY 5

The participants learned and tested on themselves the rehabilitation program in school where use of natural materials benefits for human beings, which helps to prevent such disease as: language and learning disorders, autism UDS, etc. Participants took part in created a memory about experience in Latvia and project logo by making badges. Workshop was followed by work session – discussing and preparing next activities and visiting times Evaluation of the work session, feedback and issuing the certificates to the attendants.

During the coordinator’s meeting, partners decided and discussed:

- Will be accepted in writing 1. short term teacher’s events meeting time changes from December 2019 to January 2020. Changes cause - different schools could not come in December, because money wasn’t credited and/or signed contracts with NA in they country.

- Workshop “Storytelling with non formal methods”, that is a GOOD PRACTICE example and decided to do similar workshops with students and colleagues in their schools.
